Become a part of the Zenger Farm education team and spend this spring outdoors helping children learn about farming and nature at a beautiful farm right in Portland Oregon. Come and get dirty!

Zenger Farm is a small organic urban vegetable farm and wetland. We offer field trip programming to people of all ages, preschool to adult. As a Farm Field Trip Volunteer you will gain the skills to lead our 90 minutes to 3 hour long hands-on, inquiry based field trip programs. Topic areas include plants, wetland ecology, healthy food, natural history, soils, compost, worms, service learning work and more.

Time Commitment:

We ask that Field Trip volunteers commit to help with one field trip a week March through early June. Two to four hours a week.

As a Zenger Farm volunteer you will receive:

- lots of experience teaching and developing outdoor education programs
- an introduction of the natural history of the region
- an introduction to sustainable farming practices in the Pacific Northwest.
