Outreach Volunteers work with the Community Involvement Coordinator to develop and implement effective outreach and engagement efforts. Events take place at the farm and at partner locations throughout the city, with a focus on outer southeast neighborhoods because many of our closest neighbors do not know what we offer or how to be involved. Help us share our message of environmental stewardship and healthy sustainable food for all and get more folks engaged in our work. We are looking for volunteers who are excited about developing proficiency in their volunteer role through a minimum commitment of 10 hours per month for 3 months.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Plan and assist with outreach activities (flyering, communications and events).
- Communicate in a helpful and friendly manner to share accurate information about Zenger Farm's programs and mission.
- Maintain clear and open communication with Zenger Farm staff.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Able to assist with or lead a minimum of 2 events per month (about 10 hours) for a period of three months. Events generally take place on evenings and weekends.
- Familiarity with and commitment to the goals of Zenger Farm.
- Outgoing personality, enjoys interacting with diverse populations.
- Previous experience conducting outreach is helpful.
- Familiarity with the neighborhoods of Outer SE Portland is helpful.
- Personal vehicle to distribute flyers and attend events is helpful.

- Help make the wonderful resources at Zenger Farm available to more community members.
- Spend time with a great group of staff and volunteers, and get to know the community.
